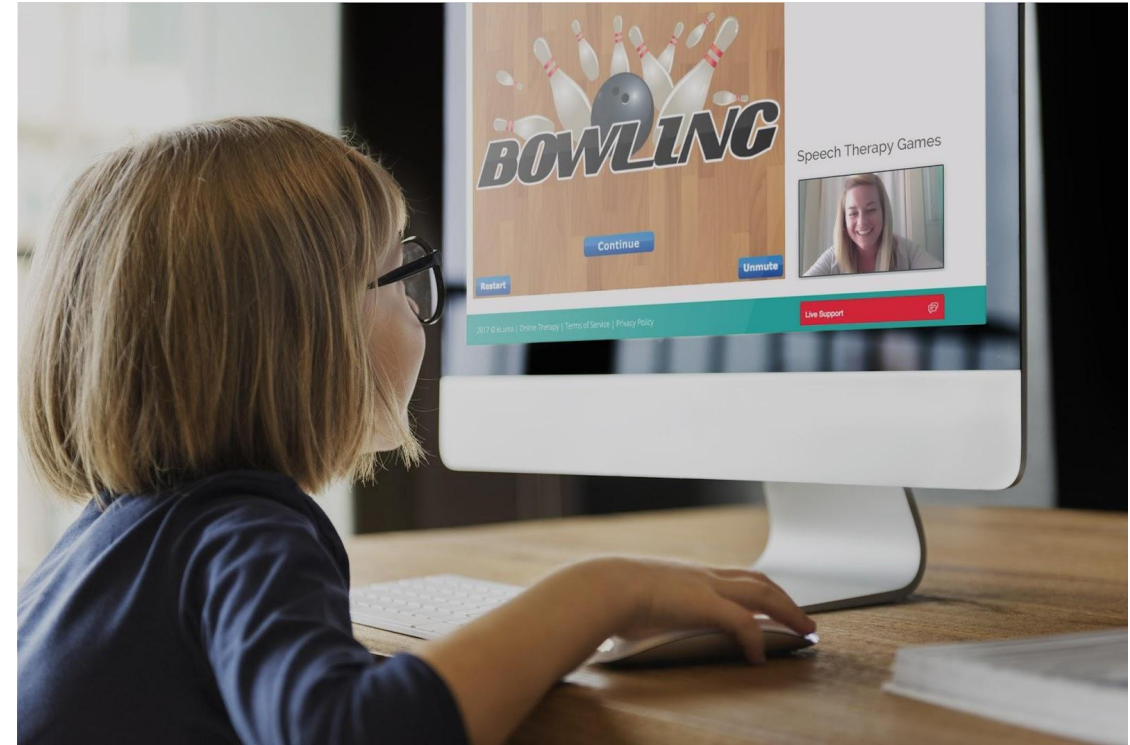

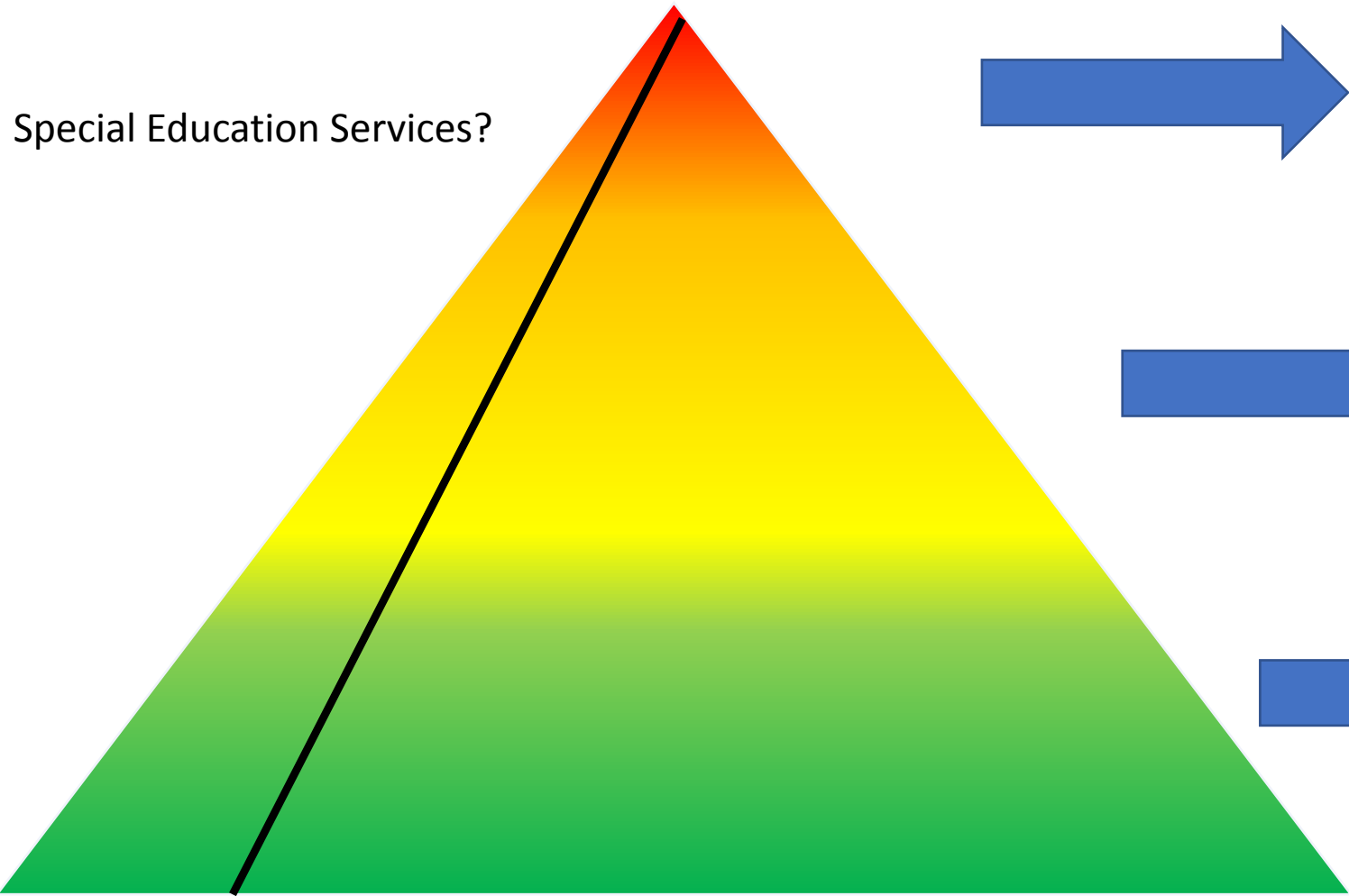

- High Quality SEL Instruction and Positive Behavior Supports

Foundational Elements:
Strong Leadership
Supportive Culture and Climate
Collaborative Partnerships and Shared Responsibility
Sufficient Workforce
Professional Development and Support

Effective Universal Supports Are:

- ✓ Equitable → Available to all students
- ✓ Preventative → Reduce risk for more significant challenges
- ✓ Responsive → Continuously monitored and adjusted
- ✓ Data-Based → Decisions based on data related to student needs
- ✓ Evidence-based → Matched to identified needs
- ✓ Collaborative → Shared vision and responsibility for student success
- ✓ Sustainable → Manageable, doable, embedded in school culture

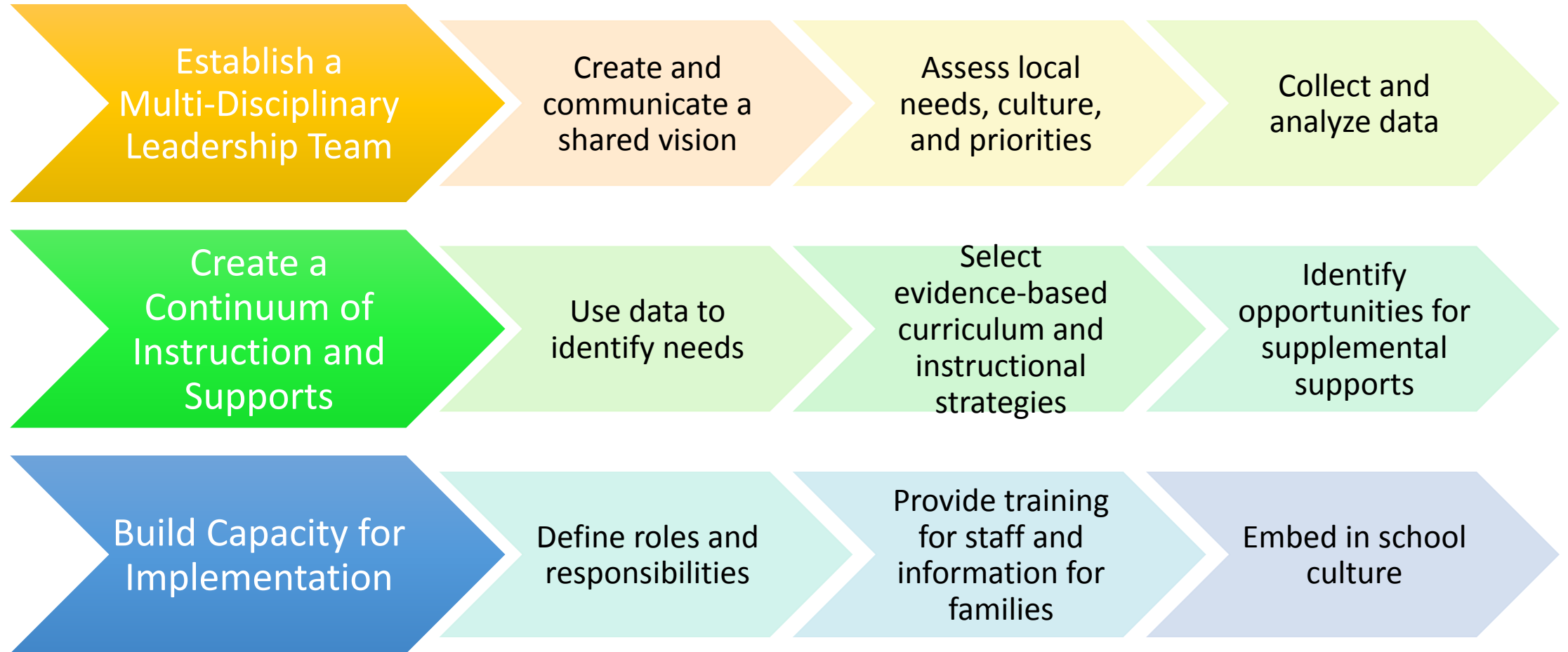

Benefits of SEL Skills Instruction

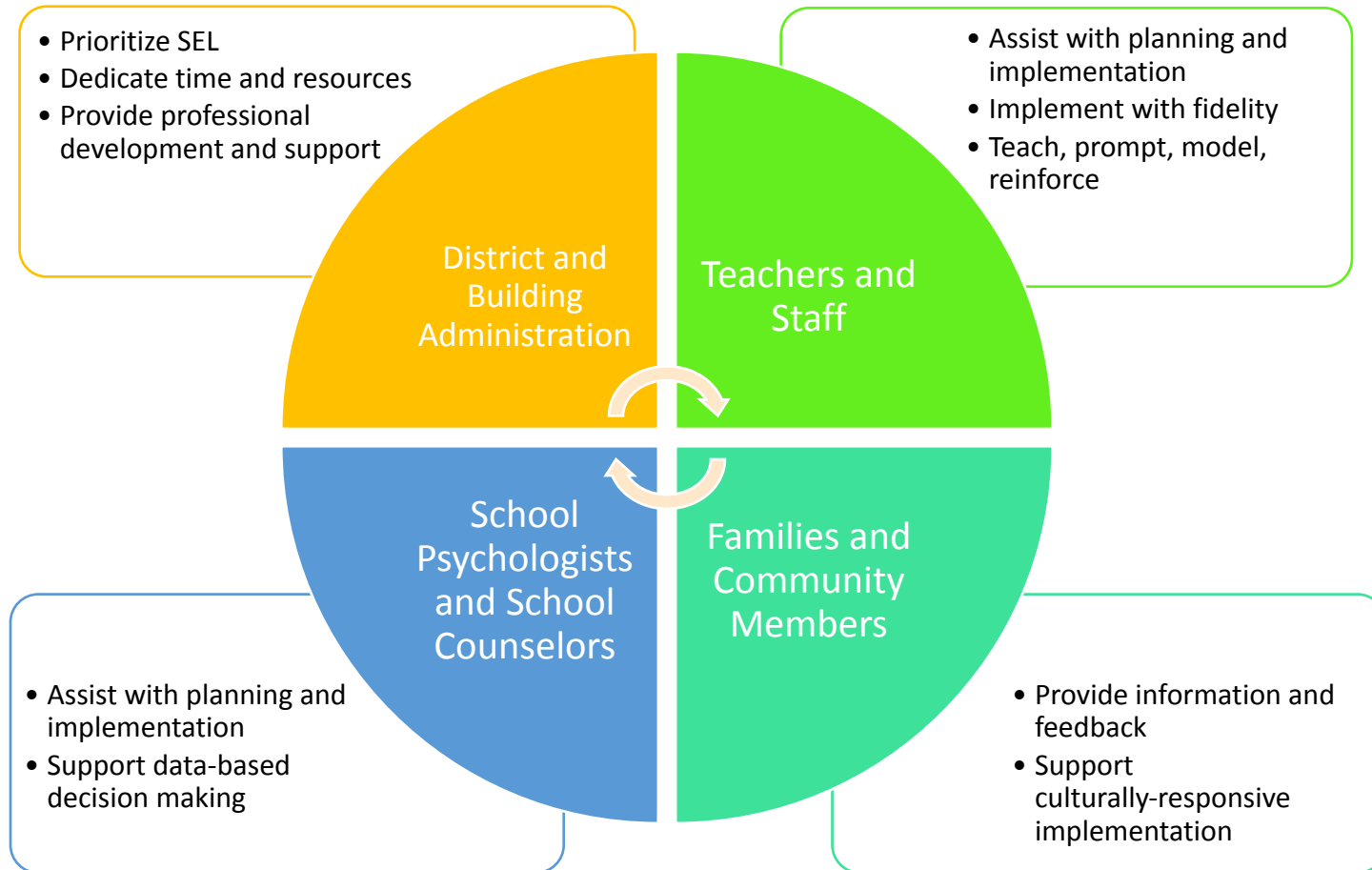
- Improved attitudes about self, others, and school
- Increased demonstration of school and relationship-facilitating skills
- Increases in positive classroom behaviors
- Increases in student achievement and graduation rates
- Improved post-secondary outcomes
- Improved emotional and mental health
- Decreases in conduct problems and disciplinary referrals
- Decreased involvement with law enforcement

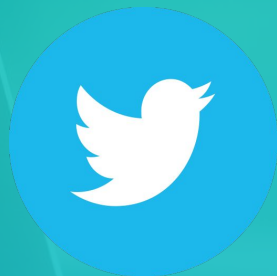
